MANA de Imperial Valley is committed to support and recognize outstanding students who further their education within our community. MANA is proud to offer a competitive college scholarship to local Imperial Valley high school graduates. Applications are available online at www.ivmana.org or may be picked up at your high school's counseling center.

Scholarship Amount: Up to \$1,000

Application Postmark Deadline: *March 25, 2024.*

General Eligibility Requirements:

Applicants must meet the following requirements to apply for the scholarship:

- Be a student who is committed to supporting the mission of MANA de Imperial Valley
- Have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.75 on a 4.0 scale (or the equivalent)
- Have plans to transfer to a four-year U.S. accredited institution or technical college for the 2024-2025 academic school year
- Community service/school activities involvement

Applicants must select *one* of the following two categories of scholarships on the MANA College & University Scholarship:

- **Merit Scholarship:** Up to \$1,000 scholarship awarded. This scholarship is awarded to applicants who have achieved a GPA of 3.0 and above
–OR–
- **General Scholarship:** Up to \$1,000 scholarship awarded. This scholarship is awarded to applicants who have achieved a GPA of 2.75 and above. This scholarship takes into consideration the financial need of the student

Applicants Must Submit the Following in Order to be Considered for this Scholarship:

- Completed application form, including *ONE* essay response
- Demographic Information Sheet
- Resume including community services, work experience, awards and honors
- Copy of most current high school transcript
- Two (2) letters of recommendation (completed by someone other than a family member)
- Typed Bio and JPEG or PDF photograph (must be emailed together ivmanascholar@gmail.com)
 - A current headshot is required (head and shoulders only). Environmental photos will not be accepted.

NOTE: Applications that are incomplete or postmarked after March 25, 2024 will not be considered.
